. The list of components of the educational-professional program and their logical sequence

The educational and professional program provides for the division of disciplines according to two criteria:

- obligatory subjects;

- elective courses, which are divided into two types:

1) disciplines of professionally-oriented training of choice (a choice of 2 - 3 disciplines are offered);

2) disciplines of other specialties of free choice of the student (the list is approved by the order of the Rector for the current academic year).

Tables 1 and 2 present the curriculum of the educational program taking into account the study time and attracting ECTS credits for both familiar disciplines and elective disciplines. In this educational program, 30 ECTS credits correspond to one semester, and 60 ECTS credits correspond to a regular academic year. One ECTS credit corresponds to 30 hours of the applicant's total training load.

3 Forms of certification of applicants for higher education

Certification of graduates of OPP Law of specialty 081 Law is carried out in two stages:

- **University attestation exam** in the form of computer testing according to the principles of external evaluation in the content of all compulsory disciplines of the educational program;

- **unified state qualification exam in the specialty** in accordance with the resolutions of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of May 10, 2018 №354 and July 17, 2019 № 684. Requirements for the unified state qualification exam are set by the state.

Certification ends with the issuance of a standard document on the award of a master's degree in the specialty 081 Law educational and professional program Law. Qualification: Master. Right. Certification is carried out openly and publicly.
